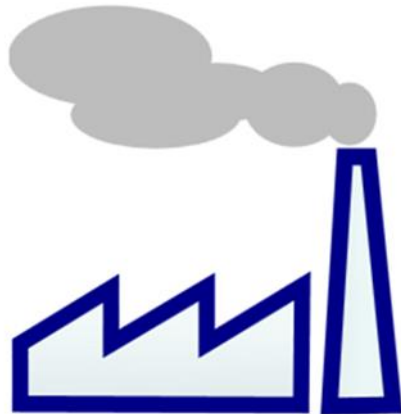

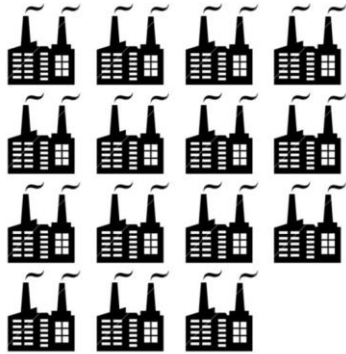

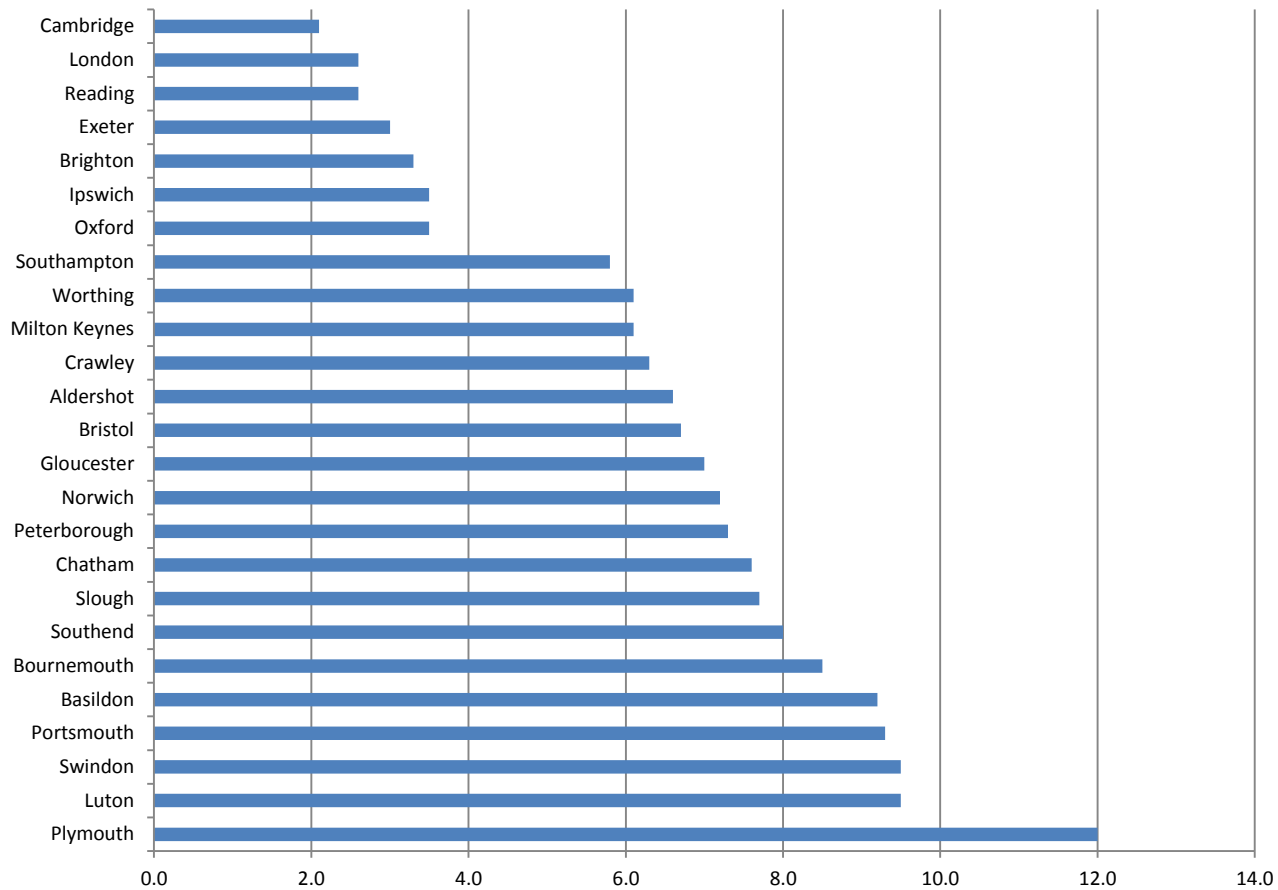

Proportion of workforce employed in Manufacturing - Cities in the South of England 2014 (%)

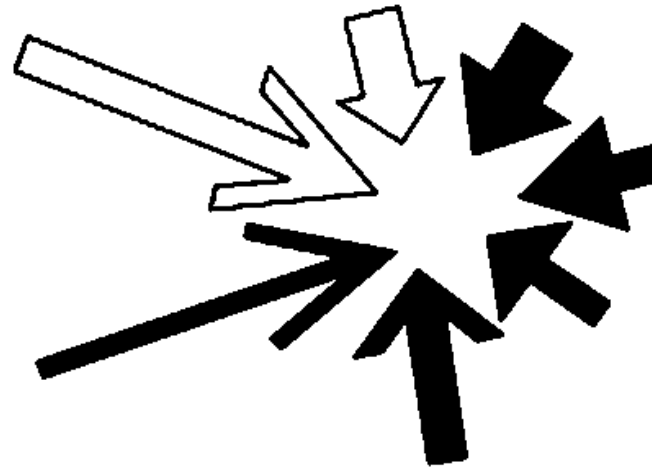

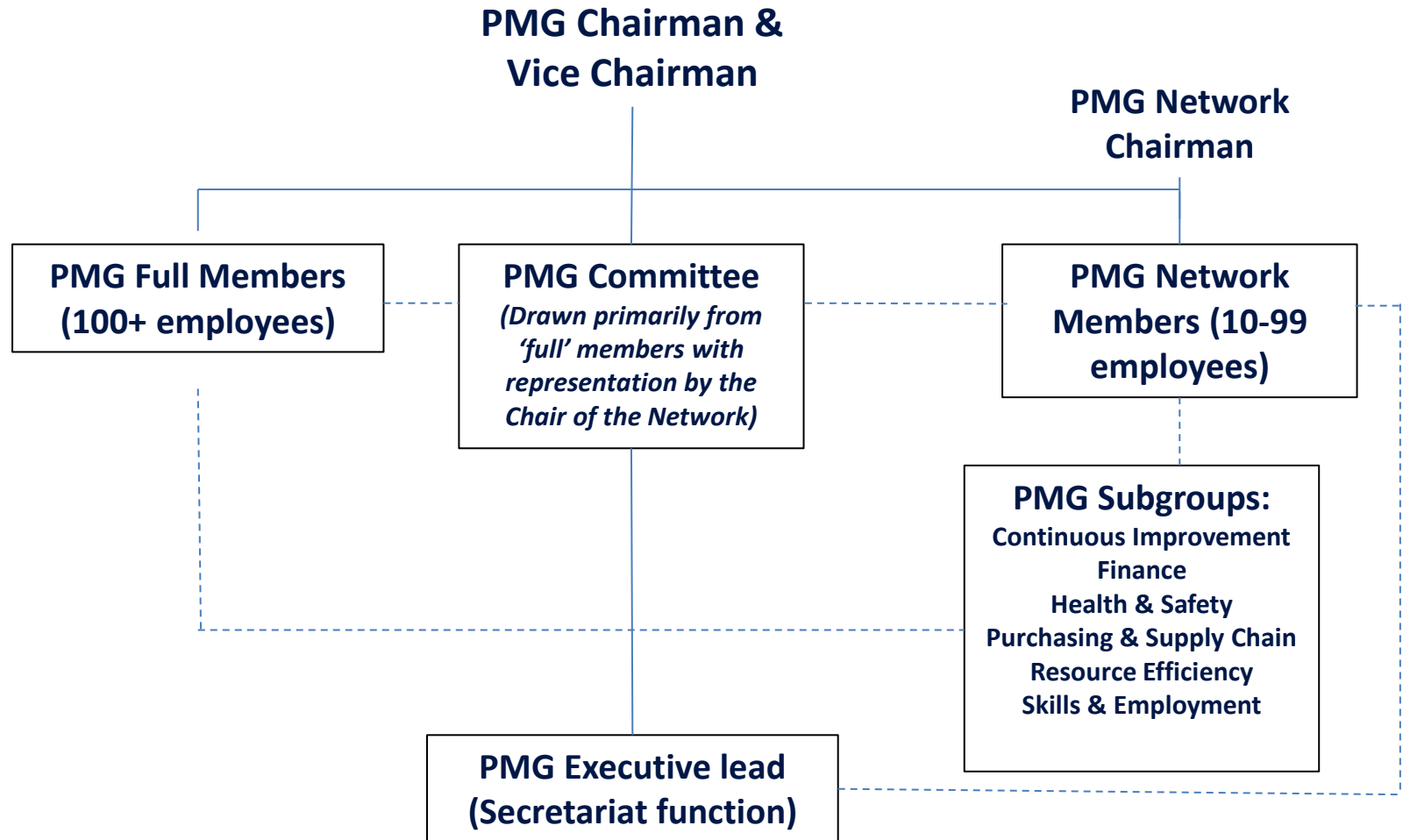
