ENTRY REQUIREMENTS AND DURATION

Normally a 2:1 degree from a UK University or equivalent and evidence of a sustained engagement with associated fields of practice. Applicants with extensive industry experience can claim credits following the University of Plymouth Accreditation of Prior Learning Policy. IELTS 6.5 or equivalent for overseas students. Applicants will be required to submit an outline of their experience in a 500-word statement.

DURATION

1 year (3 semesters) for full-time students,
2 years (5 semesters) for part-time students.
